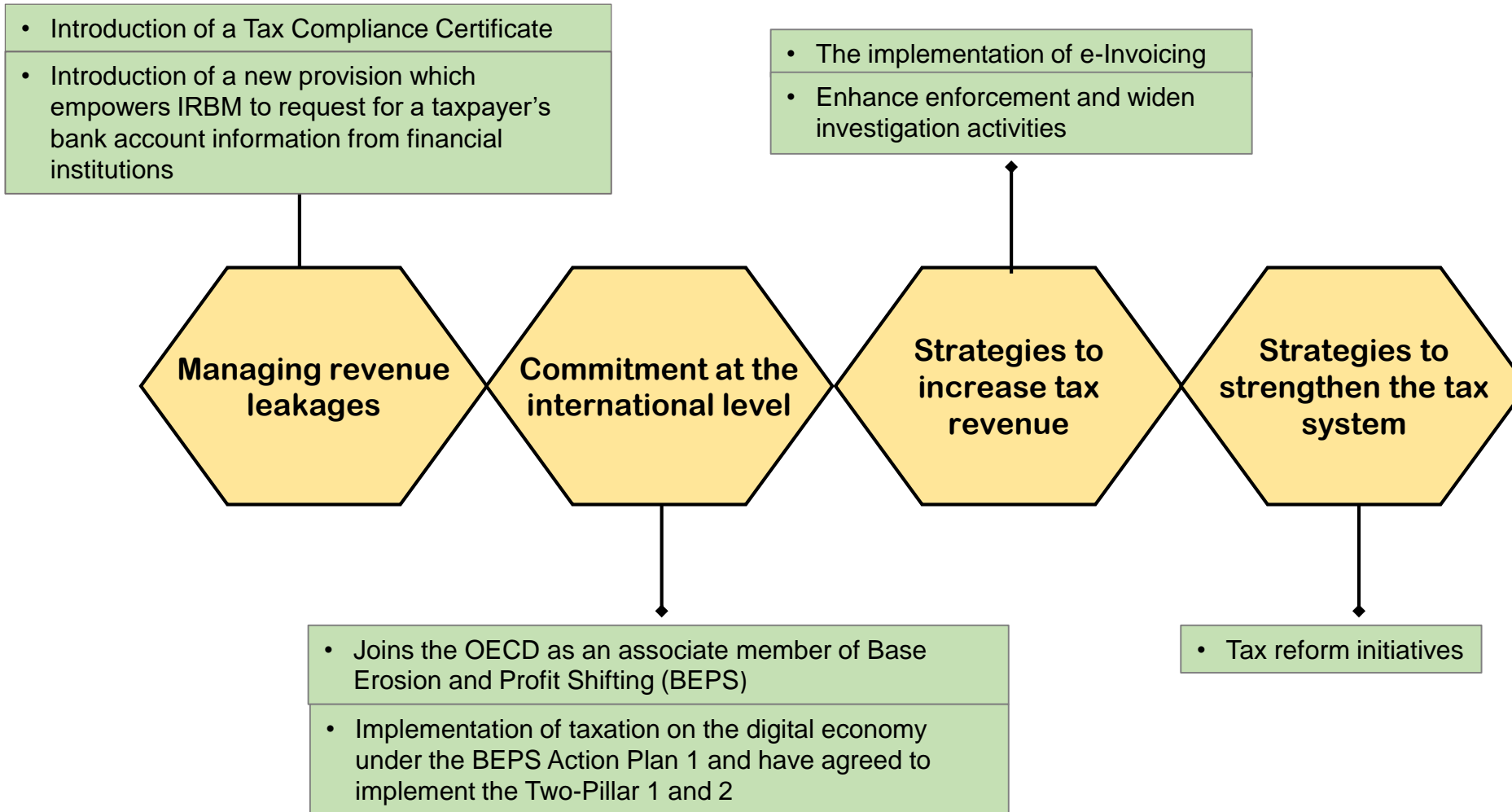

Disbursement of Government's Financial Aid

- BKM is the Government's cash assistance that is more targeted to the people who needed to ease the cost of living and the burden of low-income people.
- Four additional economic assistance packages were announced in 2021, namely PERMAI, PEMERKASA, PEMERKASA Plus & PEMULIH
- Special Caring Grant (*Geran Khas Prihatin*), One-off financial aid for Micro entrepreneurs
- Malaysian Automotive Assistance (*Bantuan Automotif Keluarga Malaysia*) for the eligible type of vehicle is a private vehicle damaged due to a flood without natural disaster insurance protection only



Households earning less than RM 5,000 a month



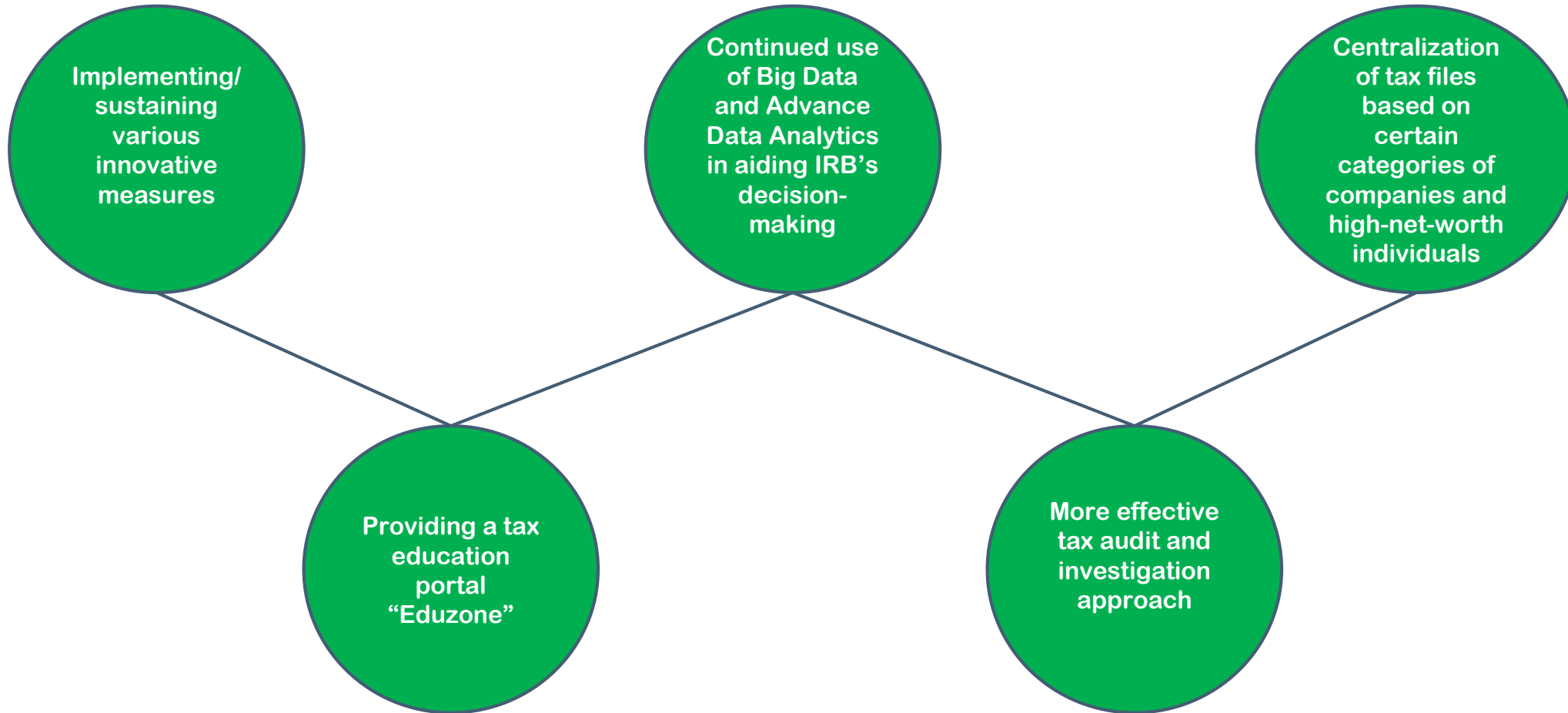
Single individuals aged 60 and above, earning RM 5,000 or less per month



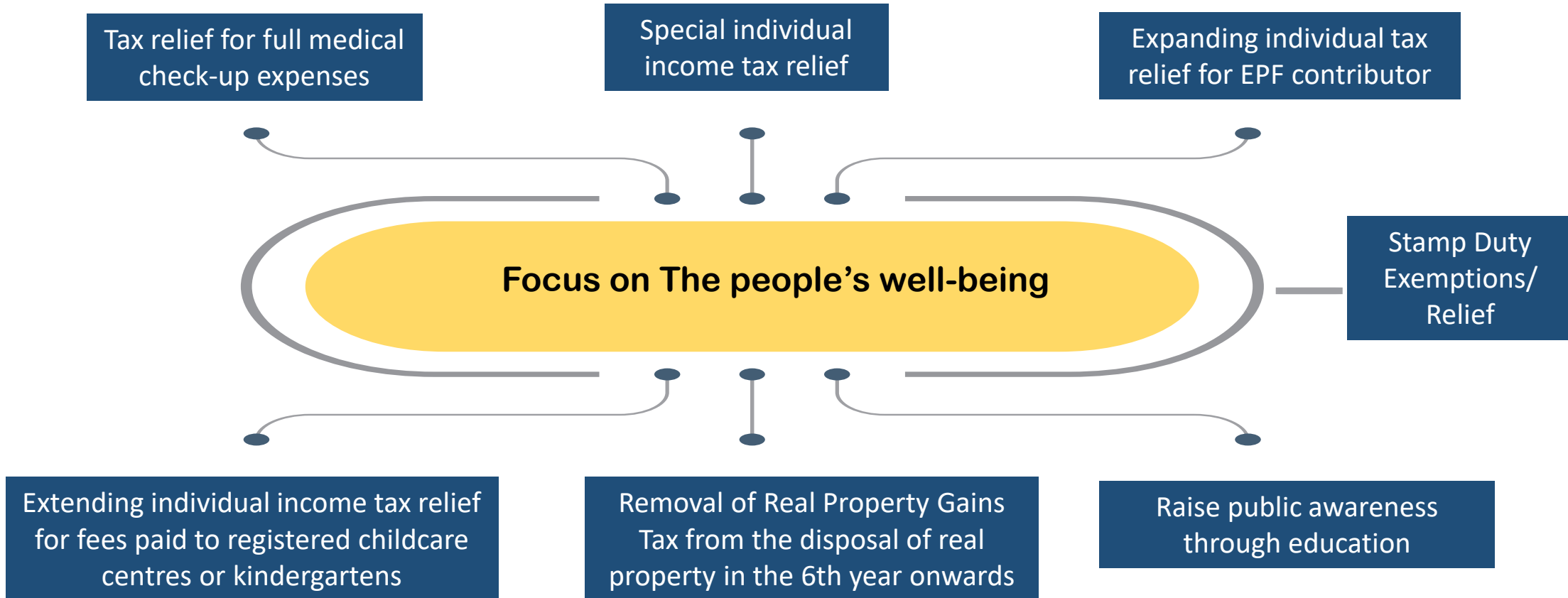
Single individuals aged 21 - 59 years , less than RM 2,500

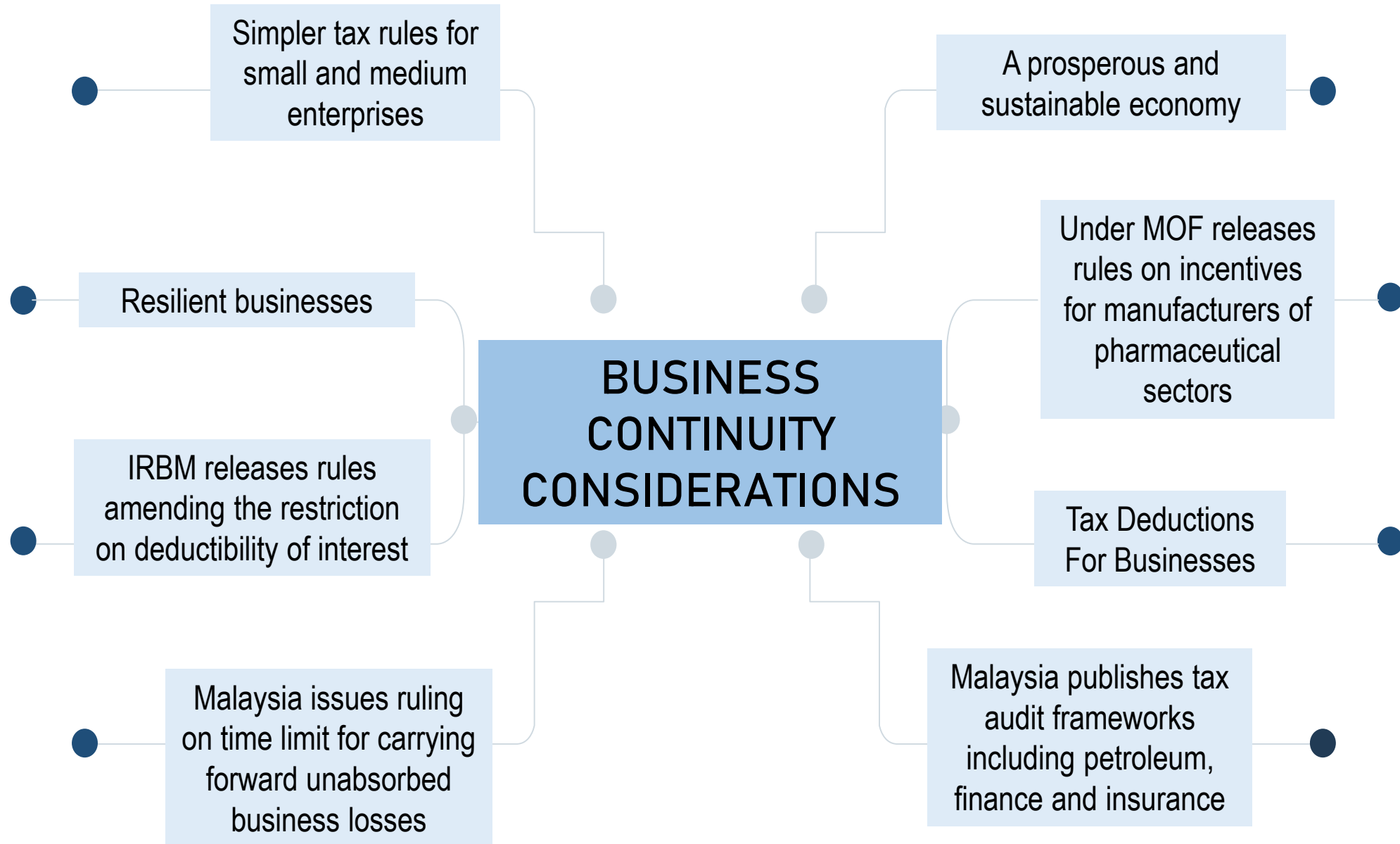
